Session 7: Cultivating a Private Prayer Life

Teaching notes:

What Jesus says about prayer

- 1. He encourages us to have a private prayer life (Matthew 6:5–6) We all need to spend time alone with God in prayer.
- 2. Prayer is not about how good you are with words (Matthew 6:7; Romans 8:26)
- 3. The Lord's prayer (Matthew 6:9-13; Luke 11:1-4)
- 4. We will get what we ask for in prayer (Matthew 21: 18-22; John 16: 24; Matthew 7:7)
- 5. Watch and pray so that you don't fall into temptation (Matthew 26:40–41)
 - The flesh and the Spirit are in conflict (Galatians 5:17) It is beneficial to pray in tongues (I Corinthians 14:4: Jude 1:20)
- 6. Be persistent (Luke 18: 1-8; Luke 11: 5-8)

The prayer life of Jesus

- 1. He had a private prayer life: He prayed alone (Matthew 14:23; Mark 1:35)
- 2. Jesus was intentional about prayer:

- He sent the multitudes away (Matthew 14:23)
- He went up to the mountain (Mark 6:46)
- He prayed all night (Luke 6:12)
- 3. He prayed with others (Luke 9:28; Ecclesiastes 4:19; Proverbs 27:17)
